Dear OSHClub Families,

It is with sadness that I officially announce that I will be leaving Pinewood OSHClub, at least temporarily, after Week 1 of Term 2. I started working at Pinewood OSHClub in December 2017 after returning from work in Canada. I was due to return to work in Canada last year, but postponed for 12 months to continue my work here at Pinewood. That postponement is almost up, and my last day of work will be Wednesday, April 24.

It has been a pleasure working at Pinewood with the families, students, OSHClub staff and Pinewood staff that have surrounded me. During my time the service has grown to 161 students (the biggest OSHClub in Victoria), overseen the changeover from CCR and CCB to CCS, completely changed online portals and moved from paper rolls to iPads, and had a new room added to our licence. I am proud to say that in my opinion and experience, even with 161 students and all the changes, the service still maintains the vibe of a small, tight-knit service (at least sometimes!). Thank you for the patience and understanding you have afforded me and my staff through all these changes. Obviously a service of this size comes with unique challenges, and I count myself lucky to have had such an incredible staff team to work alongside. Please appreciate how lucky your children are to have the educators they have!

I would like to welcome Harshini to Pinewood OSHClub, who will be taking over as Coordinator when I leave. Harshini will be shadowing me for the next few weeks to get to know the service, the students, the staff, and the families.

I will miss working at Pinewood, and I wish you all the best. Keep an eye out for me Term 4 when I am back in the country!
