#### **SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTIONS**

#### **YEAR LEVEL CURRICULUM INFORMATION SESSIONS**

On Tuesday afternoon all year levels conducted a Webex Curriculum sharing session. Many thanks to our year level teachers for hosting these very informative curriculum sessions. Each year level session has been recorded so that parents who were not available to attend the live session have access to the recording of the session and can view the year level presentation at their convenience. Families should have received a COMPASS alert today to access the recorded information sessions from Tuesday afternoon.

#### **MEET AND GREET SESSIONS – GETTING TO KNOW YOU**

To establish vital links between home and school, 'Meet and Greet' or 'Getting to Know You' sessions have been organised for Week 4, Term 1. These initial meetings will be scheduled for ten minutes, occurring on Tuesday, 18th February (Prep, Year 1, Year 2, 3C, 3D, 3F & 3H) or Wednesday 19th February (3I, 3J, 3U, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6) between 12.30-5-00pm.



The session will provide an opportunity for you to meet your child's class teacher either 'virtually' or in person and to share information about your child. (The online meetings will be held through the Webex virtual meeting platform).

We ask that you login as close to your interview time as possible and exit once your interview/s conclude. You will be able to book your interview time/s with your



child/rens' teacher/s using the Compass Parent Portal.

Bookings for Meet and Greet sessions will open on Monday, 10th February from 9.30am and will close at 4.00pm on Friday, 14th February.

A parent communication message has been sent via Compass re booking times to attend Meet and Greet Conferences.

If you have any issues booking an appointment, please contact the office between 9.00am and 4.00pm to assist you with this on 8847 3200. The teachers look forward to meeting all parents virtually during a scheduled opportunity and finding out more about your child.

### MOBILE PHONES

Readers of the newsletter would be aware of the introduction of the state-wide policy on Mobile Phones in Victorian Government Schools.

All students are required to turn off and hand in mobile phones to prevent usage during school hours. This also extends to smart watches where the call and messaging function can connect to the student's phone. Devices will be placed in a locked pouch in the classroom at the start of the day and handed back at the end of the day.



School Council has approved our Mobile Phone policy to ensure it is aligned to Department of Education directives. A copy of this policy is available on our website. Please discuss this with your child/ren to assist us in following this policy. We thank you for your support in this area.



### HATS

A reminder that hats must be worn in terms 1 and 4. Sunscreen and sunglasses are also highly recommended.



### EXTREME WEATHER

The school operates an extreme weather policy and we keep the children indoors in air conditioned classrooms on very hot days where the temperature exceeds 33 degrees.

### CAR PARKING

Parents are asked to be mindful of the parking restrictions around the school. Parking officers regularly patrol the school zone. The staff car park is strictly for staff cars only and parents must not enter this car park between 7.45am and 4:45pm. We have visiting staff entering and leaving on a regular basis and in 2025, we also have additional trades and heavy machinery entering and exiting due to the construction of the power substation and the future building works, with the staff car park reduced in capacity as a result.

As such I would like to remind families that pedestrians should not use the car park when entering and leaving the school. I would also ask families to be mindful of our neighbours and avoid parking across driveways, in no standing areas or on nature strips. We thank you for your support in this matter as student safety is very important to us.

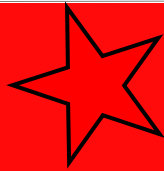
She also picked up a bronze medal in the 3000 metre sprint.

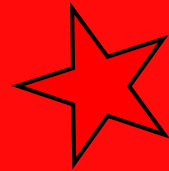

# Clay Frogs!



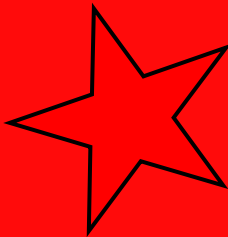
The Year Three cohort enjoyed great success hand sculpting these wonderful clay frogs. The students crafted a pinch pot using the thumb and squeeze method, achieving overall consistency in the thickness of their pot walls. Features such as eyes and legs were attached using the hashtag joining method.

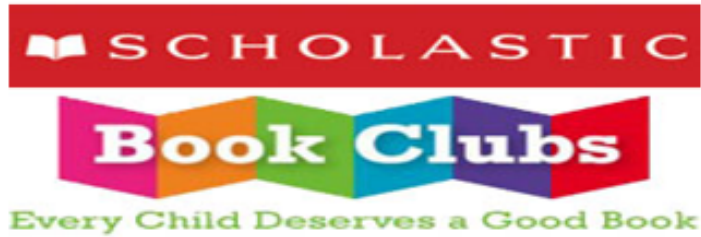
Once complete, the clay is set out to dry for around two weeks. Firing takes place in the school kiln over a twelve hour cycle at approximately 1500 degrees. Once fired, frogs will be carefully painted and glossed by the students.

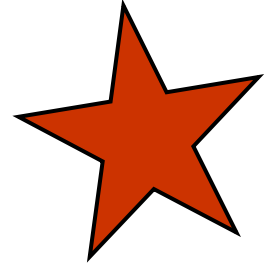

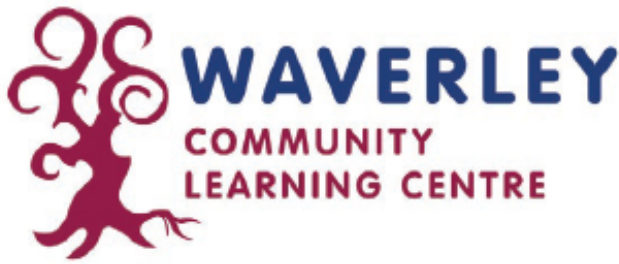

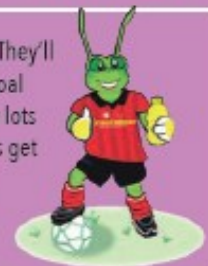
